Submissions from each division (grade 9, 10, 11, 12 & amateur adult artists) will be judged, with ribbons given out to the first, second and third place winners of each division. The top three entries in each division will be displayed in the Art Walk at Polo For Heart, and will be featured in Mallet Magazine. All artists who submit an entry to the Polo For Heart poster contest will receive a complimentary ticket to the event.

The judges will also select one piece of artwork which will be reproduced as the official Polo For Heart 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary poster, and will be sold at the event. The winning piece and artist will be featured in Mallet Magazine, and the winning artist will receive a Polo For Heart prize pack, six complimentary tickets to the event, and a one-day Introduction To Polo Clinic at the Toronto Polo Club.
